The Company

The Role

The role will involve the management of the Technical Services team, a team made up of Engineers and Surveyors. Aside from leading your own team, you will need the ability to effectively liaise with numerous internal stakeholders. As such you will need strong communication skills, both written and verbal.

Duties include:

- Ensure Mine Plans/Schedules are communicated to Superintendents, Production & Development Coordinators and Supervisors;
- Ensure exposure to hazards are minimised or eliminated through design practice;
- Ensure proper and timely compliance with statutory and company obligations;
- Review mine design criteria used including ground support & recommend/improve;
- Review Geotechnical data, design cable bolt patterns to ensure ground stability & minimum dilution;
- Identify any hazards in regard to mining production targets.

Tertiary qualified in Mining or equivalent, you will possess a minimum of ten (10) years experience in Underground Mining, with previous exposure to Mine Planning and decline/longhole stoping mining methods in difficult geotechnical domains using mechanised equipment. The successful candidate should also be proficient in the use of spreadsheets and specialist mining software such as Vulcan and Mineworks Planner are essential.
