In compliance with one of Minera San Xavier's main commitments to the community, the computer lab at Guillermo Massieu Helguera High School, located in the community of Portezuelo, was opened last week.

The laboratory has been donated by the Fundación Pro Preservación del Pueblo de Cerro de San Pedro AC, which was established by Minera San Xavier and by the Unión de Empresarios para la Tecnología en la Educación, AC (UNETE).

The laboratory consists of 15 computers with different educational software packages and with satellite broadband Internet connection. The total cost of the laboratory was 180 thousand pesos.

"One of our goals as a company is to foster development in our community, and there is no better way to do so than through supporting education," said Juan Guerrero, general manager of Minera San Xavier.

He pointed out that this is the fourth classroom donated by the company to public schools in the municipality and that it will benefit over 50 students and parents in Portezuelo and other nearby communities such as Divisadero, Cuesta de Campa, Planta del Carmen and La Zapatilla. On the other hand, Fermín Loredo Nava, principal of Massieu Helguera High School, gave thanks for the support provided by MSX and added: "This is an exemplary company which has made donations in favor of education, health, the environment and the restoration of historical buildings." Juan Guerrero added that the company will make more donations to benefit other schools

in the municipality of Cerro de San Pedro. "Through our foundation, we will continue providing support to the community with multiple actions such as today's donation." Fundación Pro Preservación del Pueblo de Cerro de San Pedro AC is a non-profit organization which aims at supporting and increasing the opportunities for comprehensive development of its inhabitants. So far, the main sponsor of the foundation is the Mexican company MSX, which has shown its concern for generating prosperity and development.

The Unión de Empresarios para la Tecnología en la Educación is an organization devoted to reducing the digital divide in Mexico, installing computer laboratories in public schools. They have installed over six thousand laboratories for the benefit of nearly 2 million students throughout the country.
